Knitting and Spinning

Knitting Classes:

	Description:	Length:
Knitting 101	The class will cover two basic cast-ons, the knit and purl stitches and a basic bind-off. We will cover these skills while knitting a scarf in either stockinette, garter or seed stitch. Supplies needed for class are size 8 knitting needles and 300 to 350 yards of worsted weight yarn (your choice of material).	2 Hours per session (Usually takes 2 sessions)
Knitting 201 – Circular Knitting, Increase and Decreases	Project for this class is either a hat or a beret. Either project will use the same skills for circular knitting involving both a 16 inch circular needle and a set of double pointed needles . Shaping is done with increases and decreases. Project requires 186 to 230 yards worsted weight yarn and size 8 circular and double point needles	2 Hours per session (Usually takes 2 sessions)
Knitting 202 – Cables	Projects for this class are either mittens or fingerless mitts. Depending on the size, woman's medium up to men's large, 185 (mitts) to 280 yards (large mittens) of DK weight yarn is needed. Size 5, 6 or 7 double pointed needles and a cable needle will also be needed. Several cable patterns will be covered, using charts and written patterns.	2 Hours per session (Usually takes 2 sessions)
Knitting 301 -Socks – Top Down Cast on, Patterns for Leg	Class will begin with a discussion on measurements needed for proper fit. We will begin a sock using one of two stretchy cast-ons and choosing a pattern for the leg. This will be a top down structure. Toe up structure will be another class. 350 to 500 yards of sock yarn needed depending on the size chosen. Call before you purchase your yarn to discuss the amount. Circular (two) or double pointed needles.	3 Hours per session
Knitting 301 Socks - Heels	The class will cover two types of heel structures. The short-row heel and heel with heel flap.	2 Hours per session
Knitting 301 Socks –Top Down Toes and Finishing	This class will cover two toe structures and the finish depending on the toe.	2 Hours per session
Individual Instruction	Student's choice.	2 Hours

**Class cost is \$ 15.00 a session/person for private lessons, \$10.00/person for group lessons (2 or more)
Student is responsible for providing knitting needles and yarn. Feel free to contact me with any questions about materials.**



Spinning Classes:

Spinning 101 – Fiber Selection & Preparation	Class will cover several types of wool, alpaca and mohair, their best method of preparation and use. Raw fiber will be used to demonstrate the cleaning process. Already cleaned fiber will be used to learn how to use a drum carder, hand carders and combs to prepare fiber for spinning.	4 Hours \$25.00 for class
Spinning 101 – Spindle Spinning	Students will learn how to spin on a suspended spindle. With 4 oz. of fiber enough yarn can be produced for a small project, the yardage will depend on how thick your finished yarn is. Several different types of spindles will also be discussed and demonstrated.	3 Hours \$20.00 for class
Spinning 201 – Spinning on a Wheel	Student will learn on a Scotch tensioned single drive spinning wheel. If student has their own wheel, that can be used. We will go over the different parts of the wheel, how to adjust the wheel for twist and take up, and how to perform maintenance (oil, new drive band).	3 Hours \$20.00 for class
Spinning 201 – Plying (Either spindle or wheel please specify)	How to ply for the type of yarn desired. For example, two-ply (lace), three-ply (sock or worsted weight) and four-ply cable. Student will learn how to combine the singles spun either on a spindle or a wheel into yarn. Finishing the yarn to set the twist will be demonstrated for both worsted and woolen spun yarns.	3 Hours \$20.00 for class
Spinning 301 – Drafting (Wheel Spinning)	Different drafting methods will be covered and the yarns they produce. This will tie in with Spinning 101 on Fiber Selection & Preparation.	3 Hours \$15.00 for class

Class cost is \$ 15.00/person for private lessons, \$10.00/person for group lessons 2 or more). Equipment provided (combs, carders, spinning wheel for class) but consumable materials are extra: Fiber for preparation class or spinning class or kit (see following):

Fiber: 4 oz. clean \$ 8.00 (Fiber Preparation) or 4 oz. prepared fiber \$12.00 (Spinning).

Spindle Spinning Kit: student spindle & 4 oz. combed wool \$15.00 with class or \$ 25.00 without class

If you have your own equipment or fiber, please bring to class.
